We had numerous conversations about going deeper with Jesus, 25 first time "Yes" decisions to follow Jesus, over 100 rededications to go deeper in their faith journey and several students that said they were not interested in Jesus at all until they came to camp. Now they are thinking about what it would look like to say "Yes" to Jesus, because "until I came to camp, I did not like Jesus or religion, but here and with you all, there is something different and maybe Jesus isn't what I thought. You all got me thinking!" Pray for these kids that haven't said "Yes" to Jesus, but seeds were sown this summer.
